Rising petrol and diesel prices in the country

1742 Smt. Priyanka Chaturvedi:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any data regarding the retail prices of petrol and diesel over the last five years, if so, the details thereof, year-wise;
- (b) the reasons for the increase in petrol and diesel prices over the last five years;
- (c) the steps taken by Government to control the rise in petrol and diesel prices; and
- (d) whether Government has any comprehensive plan to check rise in petrol and diesel prices in future, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (d): Prices of petrol and diesel are market determined and Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) take appropriate decision on pricing of petrol and diesel. While crude oil price (Indian basket) increased from \$73.30/bbl (December 2021) to \$112.87/bbl (March 2022) and further to \$116.01 (June 2022) and continue to remain highly volatile, OMCs have not increased/revised retail prices of petrol and diesel since 6th April 2022. Excise duty reductions done in November 2021 and May 2022 of Rs. 13/litre and Rs. 16/litre on petrol and diesel respectively were also fully passed on to consumers. Some State governments also reduced state VAT to provide relief to citizens.

Government of India also took several other steps to insulate common citizens from high international prices, which included diversifying the crude import basket, windfall taxes on export of petroleum products, invoking the provisions of Universal Service Obligation to ensure availability of petrol & diesel in domestic market, increasing the blending of ethanol in petrol, etc.
