- (a) the contribution of the National Institute of Naturopathy by the Ministry in promoting yoga and naturopathy in the tribal areas of the State of Jharkhand;
- (b) the details thereof; and
- (c) the State-wise details of the number of naturopathy institutes in the country?

(a) & (b): As per the information received from the National Institute of Naturopathy (NIN), Pune, there is no specific scheme for promoting yoga and naturopathy in the tribal areas of the State of Jharkhand. The Ministry of Ayush promotes Yoga and Naturopathy in the country through its three autonomous bodies namely Morarji Desai National Institute of Yoga (MDNIY), New Delhi, Central Council for Research in Yoga & Naturopathy (CCRYN), New Delhi and National Institute of Naturopathy (NIN), Pune. MDNIY provides various courses for Yoga Education. CCRYN is the apex body for research and development in the Yoga and Naturopathy systems. NIN, a premier institute for Naturopathy, organizes various activities related to Naturopathy and Yoga. The activities and programs of MDNIY, CCRYN and NIN are available on the websites i.e. yogamdniy.nic.in, www.ccryn.gov.in and ninpune.ayush.gov.in respectively.

(c): According to “Ayush in India-2022”, the annual statistical publication of the Ministry of Ayush, state-wise number of Naturopathy Hospitals and Dispensaries as on 01.04.2022 in the country is given at Annexure-I.
