Will the Minister of Chemicals and Fertilizers be pleased to state:

(a) whether any special scheme is being run by Government to provide generic medicines at cheaper prices;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether distribution centers are being set up to ensure the availability of medicines at cheaper rates;

(d) if so, the number of such distribution centers set up in the country so far; and

(e) the details of distribution centers set up in Gujarat so far?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI BHAGWANTH KHUBA)

(a) & (b): *Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana* (PMBJP) was launched by the Department of Pharmaceuticals during 2008 with an objective of making quality generic medicines available at affordable prices to all, especially for the poor. Under this scheme, dedicated outlets known as *Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras* (PMBJK) are opened all over the country to provide generic medicines to the masses. Product basket of the scheme presently comprises 1,965 medicines & 293 surgical equipment. Prices of the Jan Aushadhi medicines are generally 50%-90% less than that of branded medicines' which are available in the open market. The Scheme is implemented by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, viz., Pharma & Medical Bureau of India (PMBI).

(c) to (e): As on 30.11.2023, 10,006 Janaushadhi Kendras have been opened across the country, out of which 617 Kendras have been opened in the State of Gujarat. State/UT-wise list of PMBJKs opened across the country till 30.11.2023 is enclosed as **Annexure.**
