SETTING UP OF NEW MEDICAL COLLEGES

1843. SHRI R. DHARMAR:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is proposing to set up new medical colleges across the country under

the centrally sponsored scheme with preference to underserved areas and aspirational districts;

(b) if so, the details thereof including Tamil Nadu;

(c) whether Government has approved medical colleges in Tamil Nadu during the last three years;

(d) if so, the details thereof;

(e) whether Government has sanctioned any funds for these hospitals in Tamil Nadu;

(f) if so, the details thereof; and

(g) whether Government has fixed any target in this regard, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (g): The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for 'Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals' with preference to underserved areas and aspirational districts, where there is no existing Government or private medical college. The fund sharing mechanism between the Centre and State Governments is in the ratio of 90:10 for North Eastern and Special Category States, and 60:40 for others. Under the Scheme, all the envisaged 157 Government medical colleges have already been approved in three phases incluiding 11 medical colleges in Tamil Nadu. All the 11 medical colleges approved under the scheme in Tamil Nadu have become functional, college wise details of approved cost and the central share released are at annexure. Further, an AIIMS at Madurai has also been established.
