**PMBJKs in West Bengal**

**185 Smt. Mausam Noor:**

Will the Minister of **Chemicals and Fertilizers** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has details about the number of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs) established in West Bengal since the inception of the scheme, if so, the details thereof, district-wise;
- (b) whether any financial/special support is provided for setting up of Janaushadhi Kendra in aspirational districts, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Ministry conducts regular quality checks/audits at such stores to ensure good quality medicines for the patients; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

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(a): Under Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP), 9998 Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs) have been opened across the country till 31.10.2023, of which 301 Kendras have been opened in West Bengal. District-wise list of PMBJKs opened in the State of West Bengal is enclosed as **Annexure**.

(b): All PMBJK owners are provided an incentive up to Rs. 5.00 lakh @ 15% of monthly purchases made by them, subject to a ceiling of Rs. 15,000/- per month. In addition one-time incentive of Rs. 2.00 lakh for furniture and fixtures is provided to the PMBJKs opened in North-Eastern States, Himalayan areas, Island territories and areas mentioned as aspirational district by NITI Aayog or opened by women entrepreneur, ex-serviceman, Divyang, SC & ST.

(c) & (d): Pharmaceuticals & Medical Devices Bureau of India (PMBI), the implementing agency of the scheme, procures medicines only from World Health Organization – Good Manufacturing Practices (WHO-GMP) certified suppliers for ensuring quality of the products. Further, each batch of drug is tested at laboratories accredited with ‘National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories’ (NABL) before their dispatch to PMBJKs. Marketing Officers of PMBI periodically inspect PMBJKs to ensure that good quality medicines are provided to the patients.
