EXPANSION OF AIIMS BHADSA, HARYANA

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the budget sanctioned and utilized for the AIIMS extension campus at Bhadsa, Haryana in each of the last five financial years including financial year 2023-24;
- (b) the status of work on 10 super-speciality institutes like the National Cancer Institute (NCI) which were planned to be established in the AIIMS extension campus at Bhadsa, Haryana;
- (c) the future expansion plans for the AIIMS extension campus at Bhadsa, Haryana; and
- (d) the complete details thereof?

(a) to (d): As part of AIIMS Phase-II project in Jhajjar, Haryana, National Cancer Institute (NCI) was set up in 2019 at an approved cost of Rs. 2035 crores with 710 beds. NCI has state of the art facilities such as liner accelerators, brachytherapy unit, modular operation theatres, robotic core laboratory, PET CT, CT, MRI, Digital x-ray machines, ultrasound machines, mammography unit for diagnostic and treatment of cancer patients. The details of the funds sanctioned and utilized in each of the last five years are as under:-
