Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) established in the last five years in the country, State-wise/UTs-wise;
- (b) the total number of Kendriya Vidyalayas functional in the country, State-wise/UTs-wise;
- (c) whether Government is planning to establish more KVs in the State of Odisha; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, including the stipulated timeline?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) As per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), 70 new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) have been opened across the country during the last five years. State / UT-wise number of KVs opened during the last five years and total number of 1251 functional KVs (as on date) across the country are **Annexed**.

(c) & (d) Opening of new KVs is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education throughout the country. Proposals for opening of new KVs may be sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations, with commitment to provide requisite resources including land and temporary accommodation for setting up a new KV as per norms. These proposals for establishment of new KVs are subject to approval of the competent authority as per extant procedures. At present, 66 KVs are functioning in the State of Odisha.
