(a) & (b) Following the release of the National Curriculum Framework for School Education, 2023, a National Syllabus and Teaching-Learning Material Committee (NSTC) has been constituted to develop syllabi and textbooks for grades 6-12. Under the guidance of NSTC, a Curricular Area Group has been constituted in the area of Social Science which includes History, Political Science, Geography, etc., to develop syllabi for grades 6-12.
