### **IMPLEMENTATION OF MINORITY WELFARE SCHEMES**

#### 1981. SHRI SANJAY RAUT:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the minority welfare schemes implemented, particularly in Maharashtra State along with the funds sanctioned and spent during the last three years;

(b) whether Government has stopped the allocation of funds for pre-matric and post-matric scholarship to the minority students, if so, the reasons therefor; and

(c) whether Government have received complaints about misappropriation of funds, meant for minority development schemes;

(d) if so, details thereof and Government's reaction thereto?

### ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (b) The Government implements various schemes for the welfare and upliftment of every strata, including minorities, specially the economically weaker and lesser privileged sections of the society, through various schemes of the different Ministries. Ministry of Minority Affairs specifically implements various schemes across the country for socio-economic and educational empowerment of the six (6) centrally notified minority communities. The details of minority welfare schemes are as under:

#### (A) Educational Empowerment Schemes

i. Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme

ii. Post Matric Scholarship Scheme

iii. Merit-cum-Mean based Scholarship Scheme

### (B) Employment and Economic Empowerment Schemes

i) 'Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS)' has subsumed Seekho aur Kamao (SAK), Nai Manzil, USTTAD and Nai Roshni, schemes of the Ministry.

State-wise fund allocation was not made under the schemes. The details of funds sanctioned and spent in the last three years i.e. 2020-2021 till 2022-2023 is provided in the table below:

(c)to (d) Ministry has examined the implementation of Scholarship schemes and certain gaps were found, which are further analyzed and were also corroborated by All India Performance Audit Report. Taking cognizance of the same, the Ministry entrusted a third party to carry out Impact Evaluation study and Physical Verification of Institutes and applicants of Scholarship Scheme. On physical verification of 1572 institutions, about 830 institutes have been found to be fake/ partial fake or non-functional. The findings of the study indicated gross irregularities with instances where benefit of Scholarship Schemes is not reaching to the targeted beneficiaries. The Government has referred the matter to CBI for thorough investigation and FIR has been registered by CBI.

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
