ACHIEVEMENTS IN SKILL DEVELOPMENT OF YOUTH

2046#. Shri Aditya Prasad:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of achievements in skill development of youth across the country through training and entrepreneurship development under the Skill Development Scheme, Statewise;
- (b) whether sector based features are included in the courses of training imparted to small and micro-scale entrepreneurs by the Ministry;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

- (a) Under the Government of India's Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through an extensive network of skill development centres/ institutes etc. under various schemes, viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society across the country including youth in Tribal areas. The SIM aims at enabling youth of India to get future ready and industry ready skills. The total number of persons trained State-wise under the Schemes of MSDE is at **Annexure-I**. Entrepreneurship development programmes are organised by the National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development, NOIDA and the Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship, Guwahati.
- (b) to (d) To align the training programs to market needs and inclusion of sector based features, the training programmes offered under the schemes of MSDE are developed in collaboration with industries. 36 Sector Skill Councils (SSCs), led by industry leaders in the respective sectors, have been set up by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) which are mandated to identify the skill development needs of respective sectors as well as to determine skill competency standards. Further, the skill qualifications approved by the National Council for Vocational Education and Training (NCVET) undergo thorough scrutiny including industry validation to ensure their alignment to National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF).
