#### **VOCATIONAL TRAINING INITIATIVES FOR TRIBAL YOUTH**

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there are any initiatives by Government for bridging the skill gap and enhancing the employability prospects of tribal youth through vocational training initiatives;
- (b) whether Government has taken steps to address the educational disparities faced by tribal students to ensure their equitable access to quality education; and
- (c) if so, the details of such initiatives, their outcome and financial outlay state-wise including the State of Tripura?

#### ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c): With the creation of Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) as a separate Ministry in 2014 and compulsory requirement of National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF), from 2018-19 onwards, the intervention of Vocational Training Centres was subsumed under the Schemes of 'Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) and Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution. Now for carrying out Skill Development / Vocational Training programmes, funds are provided to State Governments based on proposals received from them which are appraised and approved by the Project Appraisal Committee (PAC) within the state's allocation. Details of funds provided for skill development and vocational training of tribal persons including tribal youth under the schemes 'Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) and Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution during last four years is at **Annexure 1**.

Training activities for ST population is also provided under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) of Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship. The details of ST beneficiaries under the scheme since 2015 are given at **Annexure 2**.

Besides, under Van Dhan Vikas Karyakram component of Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Vikas Mission (PMJVM) scheme of Ministry of Tribal Affairs, financial support is provided for imparting skill development training to associated tribal beneficiaries including tribal youth on value addition activities of tribal produce / products through setting up of Van Dhan Vikas Kendras (VDVKs) to scale up the income of the tribal people associated with these Kendras. Details of State-wise number of VDVKs along with associated beneficiaries including that of Tripura are given at **Annexure 3**.

Ministry of Tribal Affairs is implementing Central Sector Scheme of Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS) for providing quality education to tribal students in their own environment with special facilities for preserving local art and culture. For the first time since independence, in 2019, Government of India, gave special attention to tribal education and decided to set up an EMRS in each block having more than 50% ST population and at least 20,000 tribal persons (as per census 2011) in remote, forest areas, hilly and difficult areas. Accordingly, Ministry has set the target to set up 740 EMRSs to enroll around 3.5 lakh ST students across the country. National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS), an autonomous organization, has been established to manage and implement the scheme of EMRS. The State-wise numbers of EMRSs sanctioned and functional including Tripura are given at **Annexure 4**. Under the scheme following facilities are provided:

- Free quality education to tribal students ensuring their all-around development.
- Fully residential school for class from 6th to 12th Standard with strength of 480 students (240 Girls and 240 Boys).
- The infrastructure available in each School is classrooms, administrative block, Labs, Hostel, Sports Facility, Staff Residences etc.
- The Department of Expenditure has approved 52 posts for each EMRS with a total vacancy of 38480 teaching and non-teaching staff. Recruitment is to be carried out in a phased manner from 2022-23 to 2026-27.
- Study materials, and uniforms (including customized climatic clothing for hilly areas) are provided free of cost.
- Extra-curricular activities like dance, music, painting, trekking, excursions/exposure visits, study tours.

Further, Ministry of Tribal Affairs is implementing the following Scholarship Schemes to promote and encourage basic and higher education amongst ST population:

- (i) Pre-Matric Scholarship for ST students (Class IX and X)
- (ii) Post Matric Scholarship for ST students (Class XI and above)
- (iii) National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education for ST students.
- (iv) National Overseas Scholarship for ST students.

Under these schemes funds are directly transferred to students' Bank account through DBT. The State-wise details of grant-in-aid released and beneficiaries covered including Tripura under the scheme of Pre-Matric and Post Matric Scholarship schemes during the last two years and current year is given at **Annexure 5**.

In addition to this, Ministry of Education, Department of School Education and Literacy is implementing an integrated centrally sponsored scheme for School education- Samagra Shiksha for all, including tribal children. The scheme provides support for the implementation of the Right to Education (RTE) Act. The Scheme is now aligned with the recommendations of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and aims to ensure that all children have access to quality education with an equitable and inclusive classroom environment which should take care of their diverse background, multilingual needs, and different academic abilities and make them active participants in the learning process. The quality education is also imparted to the students including tribal students through Kendriya Vidyalaya and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya etc.
