DEVELOPMENT OF TRIBALS IN ODISHA

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has the details of funds utilization and expenditure incurred under the PM PVTG Development Mission 2023;
- (b) if so, State-wise and expenditure category-wise details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether Government plans to collect and maintain central data for PVTGs for more targetted implementation of schemes for tribals, if not, reasons therefor; and
- (d) the details of measures taken by Government for the socio-economic development of PVTGs of Odisha?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI BISHWESWAR TUDU)

(a) to (d): Government has recently launched Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN) that aims to saturate PVTG households and habitations with basic facilities such as safe housing, clean drinking water and sanitation, improved access to education, health and nutrition, road and telecom connectivity, and sustainable livelihood opportunities. The Mission focuses on 11 critical interventions to cover all the eligible PVTG beneficiaries / PVTG villages & habitations in 18 States and 1 Union Territory including the State of Odisha. Currently the Mission is in early stages of planning and formulation of implementation strategy in consultation with various stakeholders. The Mission has been launched with earmarking of an amount of Rs. 24,104 cr with Central Share of Rs. 15,336 cr and Rs. 8,768 cr. as State share under PM-JANMAN. Ministry of Tribal Affairs in coordination with State Governments / UT Administration has been taking app-based outreach to capture infrastructural gaps at family and household level.

Besides, Ministry of Tribal Affairs is implementing the scheme of "Development of PVTGs" with the objective of overall socio-economic development and welfare of these most vulnerable sections among tribal people. Funds are provided to the concerned State Government / UT including Odisha on the basis of their proposals for Conservation cum Development (CCD) plans. The details of funds released to State of Odisha under the scheme during last 03 years are as under:
