- (c) whether Government has any data regarding the number of domestic and foreign tourists visiting these monuments during the said period, if so, the details of revenue received from the monuments during the said period?

- (a) There are 163 ancient monuments and archaeological sites and remains declared as of national importance in the State of Rajasthan. Details are given at Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) website <https://asi.nic.in>
- (b) Details of expenditure on conservation, preservation and maintenance of monuments and sites of national importance situated in Rajasthan during last three years are as under:-

- (c) There are 6 protected monuments in the State of Rajasthan on which entry fee is applicable. Details of domestic and foreign tourists at these monuments and revenue collected from sale of entry tickets during the last three years are as under:-
