FORMAL INCLUSION OF PRIME TOURIST SITES OF ODISHA IN THE LIST OF ICONIC SITES

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Department of Tourism, Government of Odisha has received plans of the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India for development works at Konark Sun Temple, Chilika Lake, Bhitarakanika National Park, Similipal National Park and Diamond Triangle Buddhist circuit, but formal inclusion of all sites through declaration is still awaited; and
- (b) if so, whether the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India would clarify regarding the status of inclusion of all these sites into their iconic tourist sites list?

(a) & (b): Development of tourist destinations is primarily undertaken by the respective State Governments/UT Administrations. However, the Ministry of Tourism complements these efforts by providing financial assistance to them under its schemes of Swadesh Darshan and 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' for holistic development of tourism destinations and has sanctioned following projects under these schemes in Odisha.
