#### NATIONAL EMERGENCY LIFE SUPPORT SKILL CENTRE

#### 249. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY:

Will the Minister of HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that Government has sanctioned 95 National Emergency Life Support (NELS) skill centres in various medical colleges of the country;
- b) whether it is a fact that only 6 NELS Skill Centres set up in Andhra Pradesh;
- c) if so, the details thereof, college-wise;
- d) by when Government is going to set up NELS skill centres in other State medical colleges and AIIMS in the State of Andhra Pradesh;
- e) whether Government will consider giving subsidy for setting up of such centres in private medical colleges; and
- f) If not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. S. P. SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) to (d): Under the Central Sector Scheme 'Human Resource Development of Emergency Medical Services', Central/ State Government Medical Colleges/ Autonomous Institutions are considered for setting up of National Emergency Life Support (NELS) Skill Centres based on the nominations as received from concerned Central institutes, or respective States/UTs.

As per the said scheme, which has been extended for the period 2021-26, there is a provision for establishment of 120 such NELS Skill centers across the country taking into consideration the geographical representation and population coverage. As on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2023, a total of 95 centers have been sanctioned by the Ministry. Out of these sanctioned centers, six have been sanctioned in various medical colleges/institutes of Andhra Pradesh, including at AIIMS, Mangalagiri. Details of all such centres is at **Annexure**.

(e) to (f): Under the approved scheme, funds are provided to only Central/ State Government Medical Colleges/ Autonomous Institutions for establishment of NELS centers.
