261. SHRI A. A. RAHIM:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of hospitals in the country which have cleared the National Quality Assurance Standard (NQAS), State-wise;
- (b) the number of family health care centres and primary health care centres which have cleared the NQAS, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of the criteria to clear the NQAS?

- (a) Total 6189 health facilities (3380 National and 2809 State-level) are NQAS certified till 31st October 2023. List of State-wise NQAS Certified facilities is at **Annexure**.
- (b) A total of 2725 Primary Health Centres (PHCs) (1853 National and 872 State-level), including Family Health Centres, are NQAS Certified till 31st October 2023. 134 Family Health Centres (125 Nationally NQAS certified and 9 state level NQAS certified) are NQAS certified in the State of Kerala. List of State-wise NQAS Certified PHCs is at **Annexure**.
- (c) There are different certification criteria for different levels of health facilities. These criteria are duly approved by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India. Criteria for the NQAS certification for different levels of health facilities is available at <https://qps.nhsrindia.org/quality-assurance-framework/operational-guidelines>.
