- (a) the details of allocation and utilization of funds under Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakram (JSSK), State/UT-wise including the State of Odisha;
- (b) the total number of beneficiaries under the scheme, State/UT wise;
- (c) whether Government has conducted any recent evaluation of the implementation and effect of the scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) The details of allocation and utilization of funds under Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakram (JSSK), State/UT-wise including the State of Odisha is placed at Annexure-1
- (b) The total number of beneficiaries under the scheme, state/UT wise is placed at Annexure-2
- (c) & (d) The Government assesses the implementation of JSSK by undertaking periodic Regional and State Level Review meetings and field visits in various States.

Since the launch of JSSK, ten Common Review Missions (CRMs) have been conducted. Further, Government of India has taken following steps for effective implementation and strengthening of JSSK scheme;

I. Communications through multiple channels with State Governments including letters, videoconferencing, etc.

- II. Popularizing the Scheme through Information Education & Communication (IEC) & Behaviour Change Communication (BCC) strategies including mass media.
- III. Field level workers like ANMs and ASHAs are promoting this programme at the ground level through interpersonal communication
- IV. A system of regular supportive supervisory visits to the states and districts to monitor the implementation of JSSK has also been put in place
