OPENING OF OF IIT's, IIM's, NIT's

340 SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR MODI:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of IIT's, IIM's, NIT's opened in last five years;
- (b) the number of IIT's, IIM's, NIT's in 2014 and 2023;
- (c) the number of Private Universities and State public Universities opened in last five years, the details thereof, year-wise and State-wise; and
- (d) the number of deemed-to-be Universities and the Central Universities opened in last five years, the details thereof, year-wise and State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) and (b) : 16 IITs were functioning in the country prior to the year 2014. In pursuance to the Budget Announcement 2014-15 and 2015-16, 6 (six) new Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) have been established in the States/ UT of Andhra Pradesh (IIT Tirupati), Kerala (IIT Palakkad), Chhattisgarh (IIT Bhilai), Jammu & Kashmir (IIT Jammu), Goa (IIT Goa) and Karnataka (IIT Dharwad). In pursuance to the budget announcement 2015-16, the Indian School of Mines was accorded status of IIT and was accordingly included in the Institute of Technology Act, 1961 in 2016. At present 23 IITs are functioning in the country.

13 IIMs were functioning prior to the year 2014. After 2015-16, Seven (7) new Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) namely Amritsar, Bodhgaya, Sambalpur, Jammu, Sirmaur, Nagpur and Visakhapatnam have been established. Further, in the year 2023-24, National Institute for Training in Industrial Engineering (NITIE), Mumbai has been included in the schedule of the IIM Act to rename it as IIM, Mumbai. At present 21 IIMs are functioning in the country.

30 NITs were functioning in the Country prior to 2014 and in the year 2023, it is 31. NIT Andhra Pradesh has been established in the year 2015.

(c): As per information received from UGC, the number of State (Public/Private) Universities opened in the country during the last five years are as under :-
