SVAMITVA Scheme in Madhya Pradesh

409# Smt. Sumitra Balmik:

Will the **Minister of Panchayati Raj** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether SVAMITVA cards have been distributed under the Survey of Villages Abadi and Mapping with Improvised Technology in Village Areas (SVAMITVA) scheme in Madhya Pradesh, if so, the details thereof, district-wise;
- (b) whether a land survey has been carried out by drones in Madhya Pradesh, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the number of SVAMITVA cards distributed in tribal and backward areas out of the total SVAMITVA cards distributed and the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR PANCHAYATI RAJ (SHRI KAPIL MORESHWAR PATIL)

- (a) Preparation and availability of district-wise property cards (Private Adhikar Abhilekh) on the Bhulekh portal for citizens is a crucial aspect of implementation of the SVAMITVA scheme. This initiative aims to provide citizens with easy access to their property records. District-wise progress is given at **Annexure-I**.
- (b) Drone survey under the SVAMITVA scheme has been completed in 43,014 inhabited (Abadi) villages in the State of Madhya Pradesh. The drone survey has been saturated in the State. Drones were deployed to capture high-resolution aerial imagery of the entire Abadi area with 5 cm accuracy. The survey was meticulously carried out to collect extensive data about the inhabited land, particularly focusing on property boundaries. Remarkably, the completion of drone flying operations in 43,014 villages demonstrates a commitment for a comprehensive coverage.
- (c) The State has made significant progress in preparation and availability of Records of Rights (ROR) on the Bhulekh portal across its 52 districts. Out of a total of 18,74,586 ROR documents prepared, specific focus has been given to the scheduled tribal areas within 16 districts, resulting in the preparation of 2,19,945 ROR documents for these areas. The district-wise distribution of the prepared ROR is given at **Annexure-II**.
