PENDING DUES UNDER MGNREGS

437 DR. SASMIT PATRA:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the pending dues of Mahatma Gandhi NREGS payable towards States in the current financial year, State-wise;
- (b) by when they are expected to be provided to the States; and
- (c) the reasons, if any, for the delay in providing the same to the States?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a)to(c): The funds release under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA is based on the provision of the Act and guidelines. The first installment of the first tranche will be released in the first half of April after adjusting unspent balance available with the States and considering the pending liabilities, if any. The 2nd Tranche is released on submission of proposal in the prescribed format by the State and subject to fulfillment of all the prescribed conditions. The proposal can be submitted after a State has utilized 75 percent of the total available funds. If the proposal for 2nd Tranche is submitted after 1st October, then the Audit Report and Audited UC of the previous financial year is also required. Quantum of funds to be released as part of second tranche depends upon the performance of the State/UT.
