FUNDS FOR THE PROTECTION OF ASI MONUMENTS

492. SHRI R. GIRIRAJAN:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has sanctioned funds for conservation, renovation and protection of archaeological monuments, both in Chennai and Tiruchirapalli circles, and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the funds allocated in the last five years, year-wise, to various projects of heritage monuments in Tamil Nadu;
- (c) the total funds allocated for archaeological excavations, site museums and publications in the last five years in Tamil Nadu;
- (d) the status of the scheme for adoption of ASI protected monuments in the country, circlewise; and
- (e) the steps taken by Government to increase the funds for the protection of ASI monuments?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM AND DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) Yes, Sir. The Government has provided funds during the current financial year for the conservation, renovation and protection of archaeological monuments, both in Chennai and Tiruchirapalli circles. Details are given as under:-

- (d) The 'Adopt a Heritage: Apni Dharohar, Apni Pehchan' scheme was initially launched on
- & 27-09-2017 by the Ministry of Tourism, in collaboration with Ministry of Culture and
- (e) Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), various States/UTs Governments wherein the entities, called Monument Mitra were permitted to engage in activities in order to provide and maintain basic tourist amenities, wherein a total 24 MoUs have been signed for various means and purposes which are given in Annexure-I. This scheme has now recently been revamped as "Adopt A Heritage Program 2.0" and has been launched on 04.09.2023 by ASI for beautification of monuments i.e. cleaning of monument premises, provide and maintain basic tourist amenities like wash room, drinking water, child care room, benches, pathways, garbage bins, signage, S&L shows and illumination.
