- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The details of the initiatives taken by the Government in this regard are as under:
- (i) National Archives of India (NAI) is working on easy access to archival records available in NAI by digitizing them on priority basis and uploading the same on the portal www.abhilekh-patal.in for wider access to public.
- (ii) The Government of India has also initiated the Digital District Repository (DDR) Project under which the story pertaining to India's freedom struggle has been well documented. The DDR Project aims to meticulously document the rich tapestry of India's freedom struggle, preserving the narratives of unsung warriors, significant places and pivotal events. This digital repository serves as a comprehensive resource, allowing citizens and researchers alike to access and explore the rich heritage of India's struggle for independence.
- (iii) Indian Institute of Heritage (IIH) encourages students to produce original research in the field of Modern Indian Art which is an essential component of Modern Indian History. IIH also organizes various Exhibitions/Village Outreach Programmes/Short Term Courses/Workshops to promote the study of Modern Indian Art.
- (iv) Maulana Abul Kalam Azad Institute of Asian Studies (MAKAIAS), Kolkata has a research library and supports research project related to Modern Indian History.
