(a): Yes, Sir. India has given its best ever performance in various sporting events including the recently concluded Asian games 2022 and Para Asian games 2022 held in Hangzhou, China. Details of recent achievements of Indian athletes in major sporting events are as under:

- (b): Sportspersons preparing for participation in international sports events are continuously assisted for their training and competitive exposures within the country and abroad under the Scheme of Assistance to National Sports Federations. Further, the Target Olympic Podium Scheme has been implemented since 2014 for meeting the requirements of customized training of the athletes with medal prospects in mega sports events such as the Olympics, the Asian Games and the Commonwealth Games, to help them excel at these international sporting events.
- (c): The Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports gives cash awards to sportspersons for their winning medals in international sports events in the form of incentive under the 'Cash Awards to medal winners in international sports events and their coaches' scheme. The details of financial/other rewards (cash awards) given by the Government to the medal winners in the international sports events/tournaments during each of the last three years and the current year (as on 05.12.2023) is as under:
