**DATA ON SLUMS IN THE METROPOLITAN CITIES**

**NO.73. SHRI BIKASH RANJAN BHATTACHARYYA:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether Government has any recent data on the total number of slums in the metropolitan cities in the country, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (b) the number of slums without electricity and water supply;
- (c) the existing schemes, comprehensive plan and policy for rehabilitation and development of slums in the urban areas of the country; and
- (d) the steps taken by Government to reduce further construction of slums in the major cities of the country, if so, the details thereof, State-wise and year-wise?

**ANSWER**

- (a): The data on number of slums in the country are collected by the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO). As per the last data of slums collected by NSSO in 2012 during the 69<sup>th</sup> Round Survey, the estimated number of slums in the country is 33,510 which includes 13,761 notified slums and 19,749 non-notified slums. The State/Union Territory (UT)-wise number of slums in the country is at Annexure.
- (b) to (d): 'Land' and 'Colonisation' are State subjects. All schemes related to redevelopment/rehabilitation of slums, prevention of growth of slums and providing basic amenities including water and electricity are implemented by States/UTs in their respective areas and the data of the same are maintained by the respective State/UT Governments.

In addition, Central Government supplements the efforts of States/UTs to provide basic civic amenities for urban poor including slum dwellers through various urban Missions, such as - Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U), Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT), Swachh Bharat Mission - Urban (SBM-U) etc.
