- (a) the status of the Smart Cities Mission in Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) the details of targets achieved under Smart Cities Mission in Madhya Pradesh, city-wise; and
- (c) by when the project related to aforementioned cities are likely to be completed?

(a) to (c) : Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. As per SCM Guidelines, Central Government will provide financial support to the extent of ₹ 48,000 crore over five years to the 100 Smart Cities i.e., on an average ₹ 100 crore per city per year. An equal amount on a matching basis will be contributed by the State Government/Urban Local Body (ULB).

In the State of Madhya Pradesh, the cities of Bhopal, Gwalior, Indore, Jabalpur, Sagar, Satna, and Ujjain were selected for development as Smart Cities.

The City-wise progress of Smart Cities in Madhya Pradesh is given below:-

The period of implementation of SCM has been extended upto June 2024 and all Smart Cities, including those in Madhya Pradesh, are expected to complete their projects within the stipulated time.

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
