Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

(a) the current fleet strength of Pawan Hans Limited and the extent of its operations in India during the COVID-19 Pandemic;

(b) the amount of equity that Government and different PSUs own in Pawan Hans Limited;

(c) the extent of services provided by Pawan Hans Limited, State-wise and PSU-wise in the last year;

(d) whether it is a fact that Pawan Hans Limited is incurring losses, if so, details thereof for the last 5 years; and

(e) whether there are any future plans for disinvestment for Pawan Hans Limited?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

(a): At present, Pawan Hans Limited (PHL) has a fleet of 46 helicopters, which includes five leased helicopters. [Dauphin N3- (14), Dauphin N (17), Bell 206 L4- (02), Bell 407 (03), Ecurreil B3 (02), MI-172 (03), Sikorsky S76D (04), Dhruv (01)]. The details of its operations in India during the COVID pandemic is attached as Annexure - I.

(b): Government of India owns 51% of the equity amounting to Rs.284.316 crore while Oil and Natural Gas Commission (ONGC) Ltd. owns the remaining 49% amounting to Rs.273.166 crore.

(c): The details of services provided by PHL during the year 2022-23 is attached at Annexure-II.

(d): The details of the Loss incurred by PHL during the last 5 years are attached at Annexure-III

(e): No such decision has been taken as of now.
