PRIVATISATION OF AIRPORTS

827. SMT PRIYANKA CHATURVEDI

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of airports privatize by Government since 2019;**
- (b) the list of airports in the country and the entities running them;**
- (c) the amount earned by Government as a result of disinvestment of airports since 2019; and**
- (d) whether Government has any specific reasons behind the privatization of airports, if so, the reasons therefor?**

ANSWER

**Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION
(GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))**

(a): Since 2019, Airports Authority of India (AAI) has leased out six of its airports at Lucknow, Ahmedabad, Mangaluru, Jaipur, Guwahati and Thiruvananthapuram for better operations, management and development of these airports under Public Private Partnership (PPP).

(b): The list of operational airports along with names of their Operator is enclosed as Annexure.

(c): Private Partners of Ahmedabad, Jaipur, Lucknow, Guwahati, Thiruvananthapuram and Mangaluru airports have paid approximately Rs. 1475 crore to AAI as Per Passenger Fee (PPF) till November, 2023. AAI has also received an amount of approximately Rs.2767 crore from the Private Partners of these six airports in the form of upfront fee towards the capital expenditure incurred by AAI at these airports.

(d): Airports of AAI are leased out for their better management, utilising private sector efficiency and investment. States and passengers are the ultimate beneficiary of enhanced airport infrastructure and facilities created by private partner, who operates, manages and develops the leased airport under PPP. Airports have emerged as a nucleus of economic activities and have multiplier effect on the economy of the State. The revenue received by AAI from the leased airports is also utilised for the development of airport infrastructure across the country.
