FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER PMEGP

907. SHRI PRAMOD TIWARI:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) number of beneficiaries being provided financial assistance under Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme;
- (b) the details thereof, year-wise and State-wise; and
- (c) whether Government is also providing any logistical support for setting up new enterprises under PMEGP, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES

(a) & (b): Ministry of MSME, through Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), is implementing Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) for assisting entrepreneurs across the country in setting up of new units in the non-farm sector. It aims to provide employment opportunities to traditional artisans/ rural and urban unemployed youth at their doorstep.

Under the scheme, General Category beneficiaries can avail of Margin Money (MM) subsidy of 25% of the project cost in rural areas and 15% in urban areas. For beneficiaries belonging to Special Categories such as Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, OBCs, Minorities, Women, Ex-servicemen, Physically Handicapped, Transgenders, beneficiaries belonging to Northeastern Region, Hill and Border areas, and Aspirational Districts, the Margin Money subsidy is 35% in rural areas and 25% in urban area. The maximum cost of project is Rs. 50 lakhs in the manufacturing sector and Rs. 20 lakhs in the service sector. Own contribution of beneficiaries under Special Category is 05% in comparison to 10% for General Category beneficiaries.

Existing PMEGP/REGP/MUDRA enterprises are also supported with 2nd loan to upgrade the units. Maximum project cost admissible for Margin Money (MM) subsidy under Manufacturing sector is Rs. 1.00 crore and for Service sector, it is Rs. 25 Lakhs. Eligible subsidy on 2nd loan for all categories is 15% of project cost (20% for NER & Hill States).

Since 2008-09 and till 30.11.2023, about 9.16 lakh micro enterprises have been assisted across the country with a Margin Money (MM) subsidy of Rs. 23,770.28 crore providing employment to an estimated 74.87 lakh persons.

(c): Yes, Sir. Logistical support is provided under the scheme for setting up new enterprises under the category of Public Transport Service/Rural Transport Service. The performance of micro units set up under the above category during last five years and current year is as under:
