PERFORMANCE OF STATES IN ATTAINING SDGs

Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise performance of States in attaining Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs);
- (b) the basic data used for calculating the performance of States in attaining Sustainable Development Goals;
- (c) the current rank of country in attaining SDG goals;
- (d) whether it is a fact that India's rank slipped in SDG rank; and
- (e) if so, the reasons therefor?

- (a) NITI Aayog has developed the SDG India Index and Dashboard to estimate the progress of SDGs in the country through a unique measurable index. It provides an assessment of the performance of all States and Union Territories (UTs). The States and UTs are also ranked based on their overall performance across multiple goals. The State-wise score as per the third edition of SDG India Index and Dashboard is given in the **Annexure**.
- (b) The data sources for the selected indicators in the SDG India Index include national survey reports of Union Ministries, national data portals of Union Ministries, MIS portals of Centrally Sponsored Schemes/Central Sector Schemes, and in some specific cases the index reports prepared by Union Ministries.
- (c) There is no universally accepted ranking of countries on SDGs released by the United Nations.
- (d) and (e) Does not arise in view of (c) above.
