Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

- (a) the funding that Government has earmarked for the Ayur swasthya yojana for the year 2022-23, specially for the State of Uttarakhand;
- (b) the funds spent on the Ayur swasthya yojana till December 31, 2023; and
- (c) the details of Scheme by detailing its components and showcasing the notable achievements it has realised, State-wise?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b) The Ministry of Ayush is running a Central Sector Scheme, namely AYURSWASTHYA Yojana having two components i.e. (i) AYUSH and Public Health (PHI) (ii) Centre of Excellence (CoE) from 2021-22.

Under the Scheme, fund to the tune of Rs.27.83 Crores was earmarked during the FY 2022-23. Being Central Sector Scheme, funds are not allocated to State/UT wise. Under the Scheme, funds is supported to the eligible institutions across the country.

Details of funds released under AYURSWASTHYA Yojana since its inception to till date (as on 06.12.2023) to the organizations (including the organization located in Uttarakhand) are placed at **Annexure – I**.

(c) AYURSWASTHYA Yojana has two components i.e. (i) AYUSH and Public Health (PHI) (ii) Centre of Excellence (CoE). Detailed guidelines of the scheme is available in the public domain at <https://main.ayush.gov.in/schemes-2/central-sector-scheme/ayurwasthya-yojana/> .
