Modernization and establishment of AYUSH hospitals

968 Smt. P. T. Usha:

Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the grants and budgetary allocations made by Government for the last five financial years and current year towards augmenting the existing hospital infrastructure facilities, research and development ecosystem, and towards construction and establishment of new AYUSH category hospitals and specialties and rural and mobile clinics in the country, year-wise and State-wise; and
- (b) the details of funds and grants allocated to the State of Kerala for upgrading the existing Ayurveda colleges and towards infrastructure development in the last five financial years and the current financial year, district-wise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF AYUSH (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

- (a) Ministry of Ayush is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) through State/UT Governments and supporting their efforts for overall development and promotion of Ayush system by providing financial assistance to them under different activities including augmentation of infrastructural facilities in the existing Ayush hospitals, establishment of integrated Ayush hospitals and Ayush Mobile Medical unit etc., as per the provision of NAM guidelines against their submitted State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs). Under NAM, State/UT wise status of Grant-in-aid released during the last five financial years and current year for implementation of different approved activities of SAAPs is furnished at **Annexure –I.**
- (b) Under NAM, the detailed status of funds approved / released to State Government of Kerala for upgrading the existing Ayurveda colleges towards infrastructure development in the last five financial years and the current financial year is furnished at **Annexure –II.**
