- (a) whether Government has any programs to promote education, research, and innovation in Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha, and Homeopathy (AYUSH) by providing academic activities, training, and capacity building;
- (b) If so, the components of such a scheme;
- (c) the date of launch of the scheme; and
- (d) the notable milestones that the scheme has accomplished?

### **ANSWER**

# The Minister of Ayush

## (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a), (b) & (c) Yes, the Ministry of Ayush has implemented a Central Sector Scheme namely AYURGYAN with the aim to support Research & Innovation in Ayush by providing Extra Mural Research activities and Education by providing academic activities, training, Capacity Building etc.

The scheme has following two components:

- i. Capacity Building & Continuing Medical Education (CME) in AYUSH
- ii. Research & Innovation in Ayush.

Under the Scheme, financial assistance is provided to the eligible organizations/institutions across the county as per the provision contained in the scheme guidelines. The scheme is effective from 08.06.2021.

- d) Notable milestones of Ayurgyan scheme since its inception are as under:
  - i) <u>Under Capacity Building & CME in Ayush Component:</u>
  - ➤ Fund to the tune of Rs.2.70 Crore during FY 2021-22, Rs.6.25 Crore during FY 2022-23 and Rs.2.50 Crore during FY 2023-24 (as on 01.12.2023) was released/disbursed to 82 eligible institutes/organizations across the country to conduct 131 training program in different subjects for Ayush teachers, doctors, paramedics and Ayush/Non-Ayush Scientist/ Doctors etc.
  - > 3330 number of trainees have been trained so far.
  - ii) Research & Innovation in Ayush component
  - ➤ Fund to the tune of Rs.1.76 Crore during FY 2021-22, Rs.2.82 Crore during FY 2022-23 and Rs.1.47 Crore during FY 2023-24 (as on 01.12.2023) was released for 21, 25 & 18 Research Projects respectively for conducting research studies in Ayush to Institutions/Organizations.
