(a) to (d): As per the Indian Council of Medical Research – National Cancer Registry Programme (ICMR-NCRP), the estimated incidence of cancer cases in the country during 2021-2024 by States/UTs wise is enclosed in Annexure 1.

The Central Government implements Strengthening of Tertiary Care Cancer Centres Facilities Scheme. 19 State Cancer Institutes (SCIs) and 20 Tertiary Care Cancer Centres (TCCCs) have been approved under the said scheme. 29 institutes are functional so far. The States/UTs wise details are attached at Annexure 2. The States/UTs wise details of fund allocated, released for same are attached at Annexure 3.
