DELAYED FLIGHTS DUE TO EXTREME WEATHER

192. PROF MANOJ KUMAR JHA

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-(a) whether Government is aware of the fact that hundreds of flights were delayed and cancelled in peak winter of January 2024 due to which passengers had to suffer monetary and mental turmoil;

(b) if so, the details of the number of flights delayed and cancelled, respectively from the past three years and the current year, airline-wise; and

(c) whether any compensatory support was provided to the passengers due to prolonged delays and cancellations which might have led to them missing connecting flights and monetary loss on travel plans, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

(a) & (b): Scheduled flights are delayed or cancelled due to various reasons such as weather, technical, operational, ATC, ramp, airport issues, reactionary, etc.

As a part of monthly submission of traffic data received from scheduled domestic airlines, the airline wise flights cancelled due to adverse weather for the last three years is placed at Annexure -I. The airline wise delay data due to adverse weather for the last three years is placed at Annexure-II.

(c): In order to reduce inconvenience caused to the passengers as a result of the cancellations / delay of the flights, Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has already issued Civil Aviation Requirement (CAR) Section 3, Series M, Part IV titled as "Facilities to be provided to passengers by airlines due to denied boarding, cancellation of flights and delays in flights".

As per the provision laid down in the aforementioned CAR, in case of cancellation, if the passenger is not informed earlier of the cancellation

the airlines shall either provide alternate flight or provide compensation in addition to the full refund of air ticket. In addition the airline has to provide meals and refreshments to the passenger who have already reported for their original flight at the airport while waiting for the alternate flight.

In case of delay, the airline has to provide meals and refreshments/hotel accommodation/alternate flight /full refund to the passenger who has checked in on time depending on the expected delay beyond its original announced scheduled time of departure.

Airlines shall not be obliged to compensate in cases where the cancellation & delay is caused by a force majeure event i.e. extraordinary circumstance(s) beyond the control of the airline.
