**FLIGHTS DELAYED CANCELLED DUE TO BAD WHETHER
AND TECHNICAL GLITCHES**

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

(a) the number of flights that have been cancelled or delayed due to dense fog, bad weather, technical glitches, category-wise and airline-wise in the country, in the last three years, up to January, 2024;

(b) the steps taken by Government to ensure all international airports are equipped with modern runways for takeoff and landing; and

(c) other measures taken by Government to avoid cancellation/delay in flights by various airlines due to technical glitches, with details thereof?

(a): As a part of monthly submission of traffic data received from scheduled domestic airlines, the category wise and airline wise flights cancellation data for the last three years is placed at Annexure -I.

The airline wise On Time Performance (OTP) data along with the reasons of delay for the last three years submitted as a part of monthly submission by major airports in the country is placed at Annexure - II.

(b): Airports Authority of India (AAI) has already implemented different categories of Instrument Landing System (ILS) at various

international airports. Total number of operational ILS, being managed by AAI, at international airports - 48.

Break-up is as follows:

i) CAT-I ILS: 37

(Port Blair/ Vijayawada/ Tirupati/ Guwahati/ Delhi/ Goa (Dabolim)/ Mopa/ Ahmedabad/ Surat/ Rajkot (Hirasar)/ Bangalore (BIAL)/ Mangalore/ Calicut/ Cochin/ Kannur/ Trivandrum/ Nagpur/ Mumbai/ Imphal/ Bhubaneshwar/ Chennai/ Coimbatore/ Trichy/ Shamshabad/ Ayodhya/ Varanasi/ Kolkata)

ii) CAT-II ILS: 01

(Kolkata)

iii) CAT-III ILS: 10

(Delhi/ Bangalore(BIAL)/ Amritsar/ Jaipur/ Lucknow/ Kolkata)

(c): Whenever technical malfunction occurs, operators are required to take action to rectify the defect malfunction in accordance with the manufacturer guidelines before the aircraft is released for operations. Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has established a well-defined mechanism of conducting surveillance, spot checks, and night surveillance of airlines, organisations, and personnel involved in the operation and maintenance of aircraft for ensuring safety standard and regulatory adherence. Any discrepancies or findings identified during these surveillance activities are promptly communicated to the respective airline to undertake corrective rectification action.

Moreover, in some cases where violations are detected, the DGCA follows a rigorous enforcement process in accordance with established procedures. This may involve issuing warnings, implementing suspensions or cancellations of approvals, and even imposing financial penalties on the individuals or organisations involved. The enforcement actions taken by the DGCA are aimed at ensuring compliance and maintaining the highest standards of safety and regulatory adherence within the aviation industry.
