**ALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO SCHEMES IN FARM SECTOR**

23 DR. SANTANU SEN:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the detail of the funds provided by Central Government to various State Governments since 2019 for the various schemes in the farm sector, year-wise and scheme-wise;
- (b) the detail of the loans provided since 2019 for the various schemes in the farm sector by Central Government to various State Governments, year-wise and scheme-wise; and
- (c) the details of the number of beneficiary of various schemes of the Central Government since 2019, year-wise, State-wise and scheme-wise?

**ANSWER**

- (a) Details of scheme- wise allocation made by the Department of Agriculture and farmers Welfare since 2019 are given at **Annexure-I**.
- (b) **Micro Irrigation Fund (MIF):** A Micro Irrigation Fund (MIF) of initial corpus Rs 5000 crore has been created with NABARD with major objective to facilitate the States in mobilizing the resources for expanding coverage of Micro Irrigation. Under the funding arrangement, NABARD lends to the States/UTs at 3% lower interest rate than the corresponding cost of fund mobilized by NABARD from the market. The interest subvention on the loan under MIF is borne by Centre under Per Drop More Crop (PDMC). Projects with loans under MIF worth Rs 4724.74 crore have been approved so far. Loans amounting Rs.2812.24 crore has been disbursed to States of Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan. The Ministry provides interest subvention on the loan availed by the States which is met from Per Drop More Crop Scheme. As per the Budget 2021-22, the

corpus of the fund is to be doubled to Rs.10000 crores. MIF is now merged with Per Drop More Crop.

**Modified Interest Subvention Scheme (MISS):** Department of Agriculture and farmers Welfare is implementing Modified Interest Subvention Scheme (MISS) to provide short term agri-loans availed by farmers through KCC at concessional rate of interest to meet their working capital requirements. Under this scheme interest subvention is provided on short term loans of upto Rs 3 lakh drawn on KCC to ensure that the loan becomes available to all farmers at an interest rate of 7% per annum. Additional 3% subvention is also given to the farmers for prompt and timely repayment of loans; thus reducing the effective rate of interest to 4% per annum. Since 2019-20 to 2023-24, a total budget allocation of Rs 1,01,143.31 crore has been made to the MISS.

**Agriculture Infrastructure (AIF):** In order to address the existing infrastructure gaps and mobilize investment in agriculture infrastructure, Agriculture Infrastructure (AIF) was launched under Aatmanirbhar Bharat Package. The AIF is a medium - long term debt financing facility for investment in viable projects for post-harvest management infrastructure and community farming assets through interest subvention and credit guarantee support. So far Rs 33,209 crore has been sanctioned for 44912 projects under AIF.

**Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF):** Department of Fisheries set up a dedicated Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) for creation of fisheries infrastructure facilities both in marine and inland fisheries sectors to augment the fish production to achieve the target of 20 million tonnes by 2022-23. NABARD will fund for creation of public infrastructure projects to the tune of ₹2508 crore through State Governments for creation of fishing harbours, fish landing centres, and other eligible activities. The details of Sanction and disbursement since 2019 to various State Governments are provided in the **Annexure- II**. As on 31.03.2023 the scheme is closed.
