EMERGENCY CREDIT

278. SMT. SUMITRA BALMIK:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of MSME units which have benefited from the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee scheme (ECLGS) and Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance programme (RAMP) Scheme across the country, the State-wise details thereof;
- (b) whether it is a fact that there are any particular sectors in MSME that has benefited the most under the said scheme, if so, details thereof; and
- (c) the status of implementation of the said schemes across sectors in the State of Madhya Pradesh, the details thereof and the steps being taken to protect the local MSMEs?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES

- (a): As reported by NCGTC, loans have been provided to 1.13 crore MSMEs under Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS). State wise details of loans extended to MSMEs are given in the *Annexure - I*. Under the RAMP scheme, out of thirty-four (34) States/UTs which have signed Letters of Understanding (LoU), ten (10) States namely Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Odisha, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh had submitted their Strategic Investment Plans (SIPs). Grant to the tune of Rs.1,143.55 Cr have been approved and a total grant of Rs.457.42 Cr has been disbursed in December, 2023 as a part funding to these States for the implementation of the approved projects. The State-wise details of RAMP Programme are given in *Annexure - II*.
- (b): As reported by NCGTC business in the services sector (including trading) has been issued the highest number of guarantees under ECLGS. The details of support extended to MSMEs under ECLGS are given in *Annexure - III*.
- (c): The status of support extended to MSMEs in the State of Madhya Pradesh under ECLGS is attached in *Annexure - IV*. For the implementation of approved projects submitted for the Strategic Investment Plan (SIP) under RAMP Scheme by Madhya Pradesh an amount of Rs.105.36 Crore has been approved and Rs.42.14 Crore has been disbursed in December, 2023 as part funding.
