AYUSH HOSPITALS IN KARNATAKA**

324 Shri Narayana Koragappa:

Will the Minister of Ayush be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has approved integrated AYUSH hospitals at Mangalore, Gadag and Thrithahalli in Karnataka under NAM;
- (b) the provision made in the above hospitals for beds that are going to be provided, hospital-wise;
- (c) whether it is a fact that AYUSH hospital at Thrithahalli is taking time to start; and
- (d) if so, the expected time by which the above hospital is likely to be started and open for treatment?

**ANSWER

(a) to (d) Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), Ministry of Ayush has approved two 50 bedded Integrated Ayush hospital one each at Mangalore and Gadag and as reported by State Government of Karnataka, these hospitals are functional. Further, Ministry of Ayush has also approved one 10 bedded Integrated Ayush hospital at Thirthahalli during the year 2022-23 as per the proposal received through State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) from State Government of Karnataka and accordingly, State Government has released an amount of Rs 35.03 Lakh as first installment on dated 12-12-23 to start the construction of the hospital.
