(a) Ministry of Corporate Affairs has no scheme under which funds are allotted to States. However, Under the Companies Act, 2013 Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor CSR activities based on the recommendations of its CSR committee. The Ministry does not issue any directions to the companies to spend in any geographical area or activity. On the basis of filings made by the companies in the MCA21 registry, the CSR expenditure incurred in the States of Assam, Maharashtra and Kerala for the last three Financial Years (FYs) i.e., 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 is given below;
