LOAN TAKEN BY GOVERNMENT OF ASSAM FROM CENTRAL GOVERNMENT

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the State Governments are taking loan from Central Government for implementing development schemes;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the amount of loan taken by the Government of Assam during the last three financial years i.e., 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24; and
- (d) the amount of interest charged against such loan taken by the Government of Assam during the aforesaid financial years?

(a) to (c): Yes Sir. The Union Government provides loans to the States under various Schemes/Programmes. Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance has launched the 'Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Expenditure/Investment' for providing 50-year interest-free Special Assistance (Loan) to the States including the State of Assam for Capital Expenditure. The details of the 'Loans from the Centre' and '50-year interest-free Special Assistance (Loan)' provided to the State Government of Assam during the last three financial years i.e. 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24 are provided in the Table below:
