**DEVELOPMENT OF FISHING HARBOR IN JUVVALADINNE IN NELLORE
DISTRICT**

471. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) when development of fishing harbor in Juvvaladinne in Nellore district in Andhra Pradesh started;
- (b) the estimated cost of the project and the timeline set for completion of the project;
- (c) the details of amount so far spent out of the total allocated fund;
- (d) whether there is any cost and time overrun of the above project;
- (e) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) by when the project is going to be completed?

ANSWER

- (a) The project for Development of fishing harbour in Juvvaladinne in Nellore was sanctioned in 2020 in convergence mode of implementation under Central Sector Scheme on Blue Revolution Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries of Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying (MoFAHD), Government of India and Sagarmala Scheme of Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways (MoPSW), Government of India. The Government of Andhra Pradesh has reported that implementation of project started in September 2021.
- (b) The total project cost is Rs. 288.8 Cr with a central share of Rs. 138.29 crore shared equally between MoPSW and MoFAHD. The timeline set for completion of the project is 4 years.
- (c) Out of the total allocated funds of Rs.69.145 Cr under Blue Revolution of Department of Fisheries, MoFAHD and Rs.69.145 Cr under Sagarmala, MoPSW, an amount of Rs.69.145 Cr has been spent under Blue Revolution and Rs.62.23 Cr has been spent under Sagarmala.
- (d), (e) & (f) No time and cost overrun has been reported by State Government in this project. The Government of Andhra Pradesh has reported that project completion timeline is 28th February 2024.
