#### ICC IN HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTES

503. DR. AMEE YAJNIK: SHRI VIVEK K. TANKHA:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether all the Central Universities, IITs, IIITs, IIMs, and NITs have an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), if so, the details thereof, institute-wise;
- (b) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the details of the number of vacant positions on the ICC panels, institutewise;
- (d) the details of the sexual harassment cases reported by students, faculty and non-faculty staff in the Central Universities, IITs, IIITs, IIMs, and NITs, institute-wise, year-wise, in the last five years; and
- (e) the details of the action taken on the above-mentioned cases, along with the details of cases resolved?

#### **ANSWER**

### THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (c): All the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are required to constitute Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) as per University Grants Commission (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2015. The Central Government, University Grants Commission (UGC) and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) issues advisories to the HEIs to constitute ICC in their Institutes from time to time.

Action against institutions for non-compliance of the University Grants Commission (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2015 are taken by the UGC as per the provision of clause 12 of the said Regulations.

(d) & (e): The details of the sexual harassment cases reported by students, faculty and non-faculty staff and details of action taken in the Central Universities, IITs, IIMs, and NITs, institute-wise, year-wise, in the last five years are as follows:-
