- (c) the number of security force personnel killed in Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh since 2019, year-wise details thereof; and
- (d) the number of terrorists killed in Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh since 2019, year-wise details thereof?

(a) to (d): The Government has a policy of zero tolerance against terrorism and the security situation has improved significantly in Jammu and Kashmir. Details are as under:
