AMENDMENT IN MODEL CONCESSION AGREEMENT FOR BOT PROJECTS

564. SHRI JAGGESH:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is making efforts to fast-track clearances and make the entire system transparent and time bound to make Built-Operate-Transfer (BOT) projects attractive;
- (b) whether Government proposes to amend the model concession agreement for Built-Operate-Transfer (BOT) model to attract investments; and
- (c) if so, the details of projects proposed to bid out with estimated cost and length to be covered?

- (a) and (b) A transparent and time bound system is in place. However, based on the experience gained during implementation of projects, improvements in provisions of Standard Model Concession Agreement (MCA) is a continuous process.
- (c) The projects are bid out after the administrative approval of the competent authority in accordance with a laid down procedure.
