**GREENFIELD CORRIDORS UNDER BHARATMALA PARIYOJANA**

580. SHRI B. LINGAIAH YADAV:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has announced Greenfield Corridors aimed at enhancing road connectivity in some States and also laid foundation stone for some National Highway projects under the Bharat Pariyojana scheme;
- (b) if so, State-wise details thereof for last five years under this scheme and through other various schemes;
- (c) whether the infrastructure development and road connectivity would enhance the State's appeal to tourists worldwide including the construction of Greenfield Corridors/Brownfield corridors; and
- (d) if so, the details of stretches estimated State-wise to reduce travel time between various destinations in the States along with funds sanctioned/spent therefor, State-wise till now?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(a) and (b) Yes Sir. Twenty five Greenfield high speed corridors have been envisaged for development under Bharatmala Pariyojana. The State-wise details of such Greenfield High Speed access-controlled corridor are enclosed at Annexure-I.

(c) and (d) Yes Sir. Government of India in October 2017 approved the Phase I of Bharatmala Pariyojana for development of 34,800 km of National Highway corridors. Under the said Pariyojana, projects are being executed under the different categories i.e. Economic Corridors Development, Inter-corridor and Feeder Routes Development, National Corridors Efficiency Improvement, Border and International Connectivity Roads, Coastal and Port Connectivity Roads and Expressways. Bharatmala Pariyojana is expected to substantially improve the logistics efficiency and connectivity in the country. Development of high speed corridors is expected to reduce the travel time by 40-50% in selected economic nodes. State wise summary of Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I is enclosed at Annexure-II.
