Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Skill Development Training Centre established in the country during the last three years, details thereof, State-Wise;
- (b) the number of such centers which are functional as on date in different States and amount of fund spent by Government in this regard during the last three year; and
- (c) the amount of fund which remained unutilized, details thereof?

(a) to (c) Under the Govt. of India's Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through an extensive network of skill development centres /institutes under various schemes, viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society across the country. The SIM aims at enabling youth of India to get future ready & industry ready skills.

Under schemes of MSDE, Training Centres (TCs) are set up on need base to impart training across the country. Details of state-wise training centres under the schemes are given at **Annexure-I**. The state-wise funds released under PMKVY, JSS and NAPS during 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 are given at **Annexure-II**.

Day to day administration as well as financial control in respect of ITIs lies with the respective State Governments/Union Territory Administrations.
