- Assam on 16th January 2023 under the Natural Category but the Government has decided to prioritise the dossier of 'Moidams-the Mound-Burial system of Ahom Dynasty' from Assam for the nomination cycle 2023-24. This year, for nomination cycle 2024-25, Government has prioritized nomination dossier of 'Maratha Military Landscapes of India' from Maharashtra. Only one dossier can be submitted from the State Party for a nomination cycle as per the Operational Guidelines, 2023.
