National Mission on Libraries(NML) Scheme: - Ministry of Culture under its scheme National Mission on Libraries (NML) has sanctioned Financial Assistance to the H.K.M. State Library, Bhubaneswar and District Library, Ganjam in the State of Odisha.

Archaeological Survey of India (ASI): ASI has three site museums at (i) Ratnagiri; (ii) Lalitagiri and (iii) Konark in the state of Odisha.

Lalit Kala Akademi: - The Lalit Kala Akademi, New Delhi has established its regional Centre at Bhubaneswar since 1988, to promote and inspire the visual artist by regularly organizing Art Camp/Workshops/Exhibition/Art Festival inviting artists from all across the country including Odisha.

Performing Arts: - The Ministry of Culture has provided financial assistance under the umbrella scheme of Kala Sanskriti Vikas Yojana (KSVY) to the beneficiaries of Odisha as given hereunder: -
