Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantum of foodgrains allocated for distribution and actually distributed under the National Food Security Act (NFSA) since its inception, State-wise, food-grain-wise, yearwise;
- (b) the number of beneficiaries registered and benefited under the NFSA since its inception, State-wise, year-wise; and
- (c) the details of the subsidy sanctioned, released and utilised under the NFSA since its inception, State-wise, foodgrain-wise, year-wise?

(a): The State/Union Territory-wise allocation and off-take details of the foodgrains (Rice and Wheat) since 2013-14 State-wise, year-wise is at Annexure-I(a) for Rice and Annexure-I(b) for Wheat. Offtake/Lifting and distribution of foodgrains is a continuous process. States/UT's lift foodgrains from Central Pool for distribution as per requirement/entitlement. States/UT's are also allowed to lift foodgrains in advance (higher quantity based on supply chain requirements) for future distribution cycles, owing to their local exigencies.

In order to ameliorate the hardships faced by the poor due to economic disruption caused by COVID-19 Pandemic, free-of-cost foodgrains (Rice/Wheat) to about 80 Crore beneficiaries at the scale of 5 Kg per person per month were allocated under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY), over and above the regular entitlements. A total quantity of approx. 1118 LMT foodgrains had been allocated under PMGKAY (Phase I-VII) for the period of 28 months from April 2020 to December 2022 with a total planned financial outlay was about Rs. 3.91 lakh crore. In addition to above, Government of India had also allocated 5.73 LMT of Pulses and 9.02 LMT of Whole Chana under PMGKAY.

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The Central Government, in order to remove the financial burden of the poor beneficiaries and to ensure nationwide uniformity and effective implementation of the programme for support of the poor, had decided to provide food grains free of cost to Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) households and Priority Households (PHH) beneficiaries, beginning from 1st January 2023 under PMGKAY. From January 2023 to December 2023, total 553.47 LMT of foodgrains (Wheat and Rice) has been allocated under PMGKAY.

Keeping in view welfare of the beneficiaries of PMGKAY in terms of accessibility, affordability and availability of food grains for the poor and to maintain uniformity across the States, the Government has decided to continue to provide free food grains to about 81.35 crore beneficiaries (i.e. AAY households and PHH) under the PMGKAY for a period of five years with effect from 1st January, 2024 with an estimated financial outlay of Rs 11.80 lakh crore. The entire cost of the food subsidy under the PMGKAY is to be incurred by the Government of India.

(b): The Act provides for coverage of upto 75% of the rural and upto 50% of the urban population, at the all-India level, for receiving highly subsidized foodgrains. The details of State/UT-wise beneficiaries presently covered is at Annexure-II.

The Targeted Public Distribution System (Control) Order, 2015 provides that the State Government shall review the list of eligible households for the purpose of deletion of ineligible household or inclusion of eligible households.

The Central Government has issued advisory, from time to time, to all the States/Union Territories to identify all eligible and poor persons/ households including vulnerable Sections of the Society for inclusion under the scheme. States are undertaking cleaning up of their beneficiary database so that bogus ration cards get deleted and better targeting of rightful beneficiaries is ensured. Thus, deletion of ineligible beneficiaries and addition of eligible beneficiaries is a continuous process.

(c) States are allocated food grains at prescribed rates. Difference between Economic Cost and Central Issue Price (CIP) at which foodgrains are issued to States are reimbursed to Food Corporation of India (FCI) and DCP (Decentralized Procurement) States as food subsidy.

The claims of State Governments are processed keeping in view the opening and closing balance of stocks, procurement, allocation and distribution of food grains and quantity available on IM-PDS (Integrated Management of Public Distribution System) portal, Food Corporation of India's reconciliation, Utilization Certificates received, Economic Cost of food grains, prevalent guidelines etc., among others. This is an ongoing and continuous process. Details of funds released by Government of India towards food subsidy to FCI & DCP States since 2013-14 onwards are at Annexure III. State wise details of Food Subsidy released to DCP States since 2013-14 onwards is at Annexure IV.

In addition to above, funds are also released to States/UTs under the scheme "Assistance to State Agencies for intra-State movement of foodgrains and FPS dealers' margin" since 2015-16 and statement is at Annexure-V.
