(d) whether State Government of Maharashtra has sought more boats under phase 2 and phase 3 of CSS; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and the response of Government thereto?

(a) to (e): Under the Coastal Security Scheme Phase-I, Maharashtra has been sanctioned 28 boats in consultation with the State Government. However, proposal for further procurement of boats under Coastal Security Scheme phase-II was not considered during the extension of the scheme. The Coastal Security Scheme Phase-II concluded in the year 2020 and is presently not under implementation.
